TO GET TO YOUR MATH WORK:

1. Click on **Clever** when you login to your computer. Sign in using your Google Account. You will see the Zearn and XtraMath icons when you login. Click on each of them to complete your work.

ZEARN: Complete at least 3 ONLINE Zearn missions per week!

- Use your Zearn Notes that we gave you to complete this work!
- Each lesson has an exit ticket. Make sure you complete it to see if you understood the lesson!
- Show all of your work in your Zearn Notes. Bring your finished packet back to school in August.
- You will take an assessment on this work when you return to school in August.

XTRA MATH: Work on xtra math at least 3 days per week!

- This will build your fact fluency.
- Lessons are short! It will only take about 5 minutes to complete each time you log in.

TO GET TO YOUR READING WORK:

Review your child's KIDS A-Z login sheet in this packet! Once your child logs in, he/she will take a placement test FIRST to get a summer reading level.

RAZ: Try to read 30 minutes everyday!!!! You should read at least 90 minutes per week.

- Listen to the book, read the book AND take the quiz!
- You can go back to the story from the quiz to find your answers.

When you come back in August we will update your IRLA reading level! 5th graders have a reading goal of **ORANGE!** Reading all summer will help you achieve this goal!!
